Requirements for Providing Child Care on Base

To provide child care in base housing you **must be licensed** through the Laughlin Family Child Care (FCC) Office.

This applies to individuals who are paid to provide regular child care in their own home amounting to over ten hours per week.

Measures can be taken if you are providing more than 10 hours of care per week if not licensed through Family Child Care.
